Each year, CCS along with Cornerstone Church receives annual pledges to pay for the school facility. All money given to this fund is tax-deductible.

Billing Procedure and Refund Policy

Parents may pay in full or in ten (10) monthly installments with the final payment due May 1. Parents who pay tuition in full by the first (1st) of August receive a five percent (5%) discount.

Payments are due on the first (1st) day of each month. The initial payment is billed on July 15 and due on the first (1st) of August. If the school receives payment after the fifth (5th) of the month, we will apply a service charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) to that account.

If an account becomes more than two months past due, children are subject to suspension until the school receives full payment or the Principal receives and accepts a suitable repayment plan from the student's parents. The school office releases end-of-the-year report cards, SAT results, transcripts and any other records when all financial obligations are met.

If a student withdraws from the school for any reason or if a student enters after the school year has begun, CCS prorates tuition charges according to the actual number of months enrolled. We consider any partial month as a full month for tuition purposes. In most circumstances the curriculum fee will not be prorated. The school makes no tuition deductions or refunds due to student absences for any reason during the school year, regardless of the cause of such absences. If parents choose to withdraw their child before the school year begins or during the school year, written parental notification must be given to the school office. The effective date of the student withdrawal is no earlier than the receipt date of the written parental notification. No refunds will be given on the registration fee (\$100 per new student or \$50 per re-enrolled student).
